MRS. SARAH LOBER.

Was Mother of **Policeman Drowned
on March 10.**

Mrs. Sarah Lober, mother of Police-
man John Lober, who was drowned
when a launch upset in the Hell Gate
rapids on March 10, died yesterday at
the home of her son-in-law, Lieut. John
Diefenthaler of the First branch de-

fective bureau, at 506 West 169th street.

Diefenthaler says Mrs. Lober died of
a broken heart because of the death of
her son and the failure to recover his
body. Her husband, also a policeman,
was killed several years ago by being
thrown from a horse.
